Submission guidelines:

Articles must be sent to gambardella.unescochair@benecon.it by 1 October.

Each author may submit a maximum of one article.

Two or more authors may provide contributions to a single article.

Please include a brief biography of the author and contact details.

Articles should be in Word format in the Word template found attached to the Call and respond to the following standards:

- max. 7000 characters including spaces and the 500-character abstract
- 5 Keywords
- Bibliography, Sitography
- Max 5 high resolution (300 dpi) images with 30 cm base

Nb. Papers can be submitted in English language only.

Selected papers will undergo a double-blind peer review. The outcome of the selection and the judgments of the peer review will be communicated by e-mail to the author of the paper.
